#### STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Salary and Travel of Representatives of Indian Tribes to the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 10, § 2, amended. The last paragraph of section 2 of chapter 10 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The member of the Indian tribe elected by it to represent the tribe at the biennial assembly of the Legislature shall receive a compensation of \$200 \$400 for such attendance, and shall be paid for travel for such attendance once each week at the rate of 5c per mile to and from his place of abode, the mileage to be determined by the most reasonable direct route.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1959.
