RESOLVE, in Favor of C. A. Mason of Gorham.

C. A. Mason; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$35 as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage done to his home and property by escapees of Reformatory for Men.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Two men escaped from the Reformatory for Men on December 6, 1957. They were apprehended at Kennebunk, Maine on December 12, 1957. At the time of apprehension the 2 men admitted several breaks and one of them was at the Mason home. The break was investigated and about \$35 worth of damage was found.
