STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of James G. Bicknell.

James G. Bicknell; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$432.50 to be paid to James G. Bicknell of Calais as a refund for state gasoline taxes paid by him on gasoline used in vehicles being operated exclusively for agricultural purposes on farm lands and not on the highways.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Bicknell, a farmer resident in Calais, during the years 1953 to 1957, was not aware of the provisions of the Revised Statutes relating to gasoline refunds for vehicles used on farms for agricultural purposes. The statutory period for collection having passed, this claim is initiated as a means of according Mr. Bicknell an equitable settlement.
