STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Enlarging Territorial Limits of West Paris Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1921, c. 7, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 7 of the private and special laws of 1921, as amended by chapter 10 of the private and special laws of 1929, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'The territorial boundaries of the corporation shall also include the section known as Trap Corner from the present corporation line to Route 26 and from Andrews Brook bridge to Moose Pond Brook bridge on Route 26, this area to include property 500 feet from the road limits on each side of said highways.'
