**AN ACT Relating to Hunting Deer with Bow and Arrow in Islesboro,
Waldo County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 91, amended. The 5th paragraph of section 91 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'There shall be a continual closed season on deer in the Town of Islesboro, located in the County of Waldo, except that it shall be lawful to hunt with bow and arrow in accordance with sections 108 to 112.'
