STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Judge of Calais Municipal Court and Judge and Recorder of Western Washington Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1883, c. 325, § 23, amended. The 4th sentence of section 23 of chapter 325 of the private and special laws of 1883, as last amended by section 31 of chapter 160 of the private and special laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'The compensation of the judge (Calais Municipal Court) in full for all services shall be $\frac{2}{2,400}$ \$3,000 per year, payable quarterly from the treasury of the County of Washington.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1921, c. 113, § 15, amended. The first sentence of section 15 of chapter 113 of the private and special laws of 1921, as last amended by section 29 of chapter 160 of the private and special laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'The judge of said court shall receive as compensation a salary of $\frac{2}{2,400}$ 3,000 a year; and the recorder shall receive a salary of $\frac{2}{900}$ \$1,200 a year, to be paid quarterly from the treasury of the County of Washington.
