**RESOLVE, Providing for Pensions for Loomis and Emma Deane
of Fort Fairfield.**

Loomis and Emma Deane; state pensions. Resolved: That a pension of \$60 per month be, and is, granted to Loomis Deane of Fort Fairfield, and that a pension of \$60 per month be, and is, granted to Emma Deane of Fort Fairfield to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pensions shall begin on July 1, 1959 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Loomis Deane has lost one leg and is going to lose the other. Emma Deane is bedridden and has been that way for 28 years.
