STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Bangor Mechanic Association.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1828, c. 522, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 522 of the private and special laws of 1828 is amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 1. Bangor Mechanic Association, incorporated; powers; may hold real estate and personal property. That Edward Sargent, James Tilton, John Williams and Henry Call, with their associates, be, and they are hereby incorporated into a body politic, by the name of the Bangor Mechanic Association; with power to sue and be sued; to have a common seal and change the same; to make any by-laws for the government of said corporation, not repugnant to the laws of the State; and to take and hold real estate to the value of twenty thousand dollars \$250,000 and personal estate to the value of \$250,000.'
