STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 99th LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 322, L. D. 898, Bill, "An Act to Provide Expanded Community Mental Health Services."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated as Section 7 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 7. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960 and the sum of \$50,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961 for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this act.

The money appropriated hereunder shall be apportioned by the Department of Institutional Service in such a manner as to obtain the maximum number of participants consistent with an affective program. Any unexpended balances shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1961.
