AN ACT Relating to a Directional Sign for Lewiston-Auburn
at the Falmouth Spur, so called.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Maine Turnpike Authority to erect directional sign. The Maine Turnpike Authority is authorized and directed to erect and maintain a directional sign at the Falmouth Spur, so called, Cumberland County, for Lewiston-Auburn.
