**AN ACT Changing Name of Norway Municipal Court to Norway-Paris
Municipal Court and Its Location.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1885, c. 508, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 508 of the private and special laws of 1885 is amended to read as follows :

'Sec. 1. Norway-Paris Municipal Court established; judge, appointment, term and qualifications. A municipal court is hereby established and shall be located in ~~and for either~~ the Town of Norway **or the Town of Paris, at the discretion of the county commissioners,** to be denominated the Norway-Paris Municipal Court, which shall be a court of record with a seal, and shall consist of one judge, who shall be an inhabitant of the County of Oxford, of sobriety of manners, who shall be appointed as provided in the Constitution, and who shall have and exercise concurrent authority and jurisdiction with trial justices, justices of the peace, and justices of the peace and of the quorum, over all matters and things within their jurisdiction, and such authority and jurisdiction additional thereto as is conferred upon him by this act.'

Sec. 2. Amending clause. Wherever in the Revised Statutes, the public laws or the private and special laws the words "Norway Municipal Court" appear, they shall mean "Norway-Paris Municipal Court."
