STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Administration on Estates of Persons Confined to Imprisonment for Life.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 154, § 20, repealed. Section 20 of chapter 154 of the Revised Statutes is repealed, as follows:

'See. 20. Administration on estates of persons civilly dead. When any person is under sentence of imprisonment for life and is confined in pursuance thereof, he is, from the time of such imprisonment, to all intents and purposes, eivilly dead; and his estate shall be administered upon and distributed, and his contracts and relations to persons and things are affected, in all respects, as if he were dead.
