RESOLVE, in Favor of A. D. Gray of Waldoboro for Retirement Benefits.

A. D. Gray; retirement benefit. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,276.07 from the Maine State Retirement System Funds to be paid to A. D. Gray of Waldoboro, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for error in computing his retirement allowance from August 1, 1945 to February 1, 1959.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Alvra D. Gray spent 27 years as teacher, principal and superintendent of schools in the public school system of Maine, retiring in the year 1945 on a monthly retirement basis of \$86.45, which is in error by the amount of \$7.37 per month, making a total of \$94.32 per month which should have been paid from the date of August 1, 1945, or a total deficiency for which this claim is made for the 161 months from August 1, 1945 to February 1, 1959 of \$1,276.07.
