RESOLVE, in Favor of Ernest S. Stone of Garland.

Ernest S. Stone; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$300 to be paid to Ernest S. Stone of Garland for the loss of one heifer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Ernest S. Stone owns some land in Garland on which he pastures cows. The land is near the State Fire Tower in Garland. The fire warden put up some fence and one of Mr. Stone's heifers was caught in it. The heifer was to freshen within one month. When the heifer was found she was dead.
