## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

### AN ACT Relating to Dissolution of Corporations for Non-use of Corporate Powers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 60, § 12-A, additional. Chapter 60 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 12-A, to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 12-A. Dissolution of domestic insurance company. The commissioner shall bring a bill in equity for dissolution of a domestic insurance company when the company has not obtained a license to transact insurance business as required by section 3 within one year of the date of its incorporation, or when it stops transacting insurance business continuously for one year.
  - I. Power of court. On proof of its failure to become licensed or to transact business, the court shall enjoin the company from further activity and order its dissolution or sale according to chapter 53, sections 103, 110, 117 and 118.
  - II. Insurance business defined. The transaction of insurance business means the issuance of contracts of insurance covering lisks in this State, or the receipt of premiums for the continuation of contracts already in force.'
