STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Definition of Base Period Under Employment Security Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 29, § 3, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 3 of chapter 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
 - 'III. "Base period" means either of the 2 calendar year years immediately preceding any benefit year, whichever calendar year would provide the greater benefits, provided that the total amount of wages paid for insured work during each of the aforesaid calendar years shall be not less than \$300; except that this restriction shall not be applied when, during the calendar year immediately preceding the benefit year, the employee has insured wages of at least \$300.'
