# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

### AN ACT Relating to Definition of Itinerant Vendors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 100, § 117, amended. The first sentence of section 117 of chapter 100 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The words "itinerant vendors" for the purposes of sections 103 to 119 shall be construed to mean and include all persons, both principals and agents, who engage in a temporary or transient business in this State for 5 or more business days, either in one locality or in traveling from place to place selling goods, wares and merchandise, and who, for the purposes of carrying on such business, hire, lease or occupy any building or structure for the exhibition and sale of such goods, wares and merchandise, or who sell goods, wares and merchandise at retail from a car, wagon or other conveyance, steamer or vessel.'
