AN ACT Relating to Lighting in All Places Licensed to Sell Liquor to be Consumed on the Premises.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 54-B, additional. Chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 54-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 54-B. Lighting. All places licensed to sell liquor to be consumed on the premises shall have lighting sufficient to give an even distribution of light so that the level of illumination would be 30 to 35 footcandles at the table tops. The license of any person violating this section shall be suspended until such lighting has been installed.'
