**AN ACT Relating to Territorial Limits of Bridgton Water District.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1957, c. 89, § 4, amended.** Section 4 of chapter 89 of the private and special laws of 1957 is amended to read as follows:

**‘Sec. 4. Incorporating Bridgton Water District; purposes.** The inhabitants and territory within the Town of Bridgton, **except for that part of said town within a radius of one mile of Bridgton Academy**, shall be and hereby are constituted a body politic and corporate by the name of Bridgton Water District, for the purpose of owning, operating and managing a water works as the same is defined in ~~subsection XXVII of section 16 of chapter 11~~ of the Revised Statutes of 1954, **chapter 44, section 16, subsection XXVII**, and of supplying the Town of Bridgton and the inhabitants of said town, **except the inhabitants of that part of said town within a radius of one mile of Bridgton Academy**, or any part of said town **except as aforesaid** with pure water for domestic, commercial, sanitary and municipal purposes, including the extinguishment of fires.’

**Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1957, c. 89, § 11, amended.** The 5th sentence of section 11 of chapter 89 of the private and special laws of 1957 is amended to read as follows:

‘At the annual meetings of the inhabitants of the Town of Bridgton, the voters of said town, **other than the voters of said town residing within a radius of one mile of Bridgton Academy**, shall elect one member of said board of trustees to serve for a term of 3 years.’
