RESOLVE, Providing Retirement Benefit Increase for James H. H. Bodge of South Harpswell.

James H. H. Bodge; retirement benefit increased. Resolved: That the retirement benefit now being paid to James H. H. Bodge of South Harpswell, under the provisions of the Revised Statutes, chapter 63-A, be increased from \$42.07 per month to \$75 per month.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

James H. H. Bodge was retired as a school teacher in August of 1957 under the so-called "15-year provision" of the law, on a monthly retirement benefit of \$42.07. Mr. Bodge is confined to the use of crutches and needs additional funds for medical care.
