AN ACT Relating to Expenses of County Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 6, amended. Section 6 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

'In addition, county commissioners, except for the commissioner in Aroostook County who serves full time, shall receive \$15 a days for each day exceeding one day a week that they are necessarily engaged in performance of their duties. Any commissioner who resides outside of the county seat shall be allowed travelling expenses to and from his place of residence to necessary meetings of the board.'
