STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Hours, Vacations and Sick Pay for County Personnel.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 19, amended. Section 19 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 236 of the public laws of 1955 and by chapter 291 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 19. Saturday closing; hours; vacations; sick pay. County offices may in the discretion of the county commissioners of each county be closed in part or in whole on Saturdays. The county commissioners may establish reasonable office hours for offices in the county building, provide for paid vacations up to 2 weeks in duration and necessary sick pay for the personnel thereof.'
