SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 346, L. D. 973, Bill, "An Act Permitting Injured Employee under Workmen's Compensation Act to Choose Physician from Panel Named by Employer."

Amend said Bill in the 5th and 6th lines by striking out the underlined words and punctuation "competent, suitable and impartial"

Further amend said Bill in the 18th and 19th lines by striking out the underlined words and punctuation "competent, suitable and impartial"; and by striking out in the 19th line the underlined words "or facilities"
