SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 346, L. D. 973, Bill, "An Act Permitting Injured Employee under Workmen's Compensation Act to Choose Physician from Panel Named by Employer."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 1, before the single quotation mark, the following underlined paragraph:

'The selection of such a panel does not apply to those employers who provide services through a full-time physician or adequate clinical facilities approved by the commission.'
