AN ACT Increasing Salary of Secretary of State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 21, § 1, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 21 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 6 of chapter 418 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

‘The Secretary of State shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$9,000~~ \$10,000. He and his deputy shall also receive such actual traveling expenses incident to the administration of his department as shall be necessary.’
