RESOLVE, in Favor of Ray Thompson of Prentiss.

Ray Thompson; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$510 to be paid to Ray Thompson, of Prentiss, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the State for damage done to growing grain by bears.
