STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Restoration of Motor Vehicle Operators' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 6, amended. Section 6 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 10 of the public laws of 1955, is further amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

'The Secretary of State shall not make reissuance of such license, or restoration of a license, under sections 150 or 151-B where such reissuance or restoration is conditional upon proof of financial responsibility if the licensee, during the immediately preceding 36 months has been convicted:

- I. Of a felony or high misdemeanor; or
- II. Of 2 non-motor vehicle convictions; or
- III. Of 6 moving traffic offenses; or
- IV. Of 3 moving violations and also one of the offenses listed in subsection V; or
- V. Twice for violation of section 81, subsection VII, sections 148, 148-A to 148-E, 149, 150, 151, 151-B, 159 and 161 or of speeding where such speeding resulted in personal injury or property damage.
