COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 694, L. D. 994, Bill, "An Act  
Entitling Blind Persons Accompanied by Guide Dogs to  
Certain Accommodations."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 7th line the follow-  
ing underlined words and punctuation:

"second sight or seeing eye, so called,"

Further amend said Bill by striking out the next to last  
underlined sentence and inserting in place thereof the following  
underlined sentence:

'The Management of any such public conveyances, public  
amusements and places of public accommodations may require a  
blind owner of a guide dog to show written evidence that his dog  
has been educated, trained and intended, in fact, to perform such  
guide service for him; and the foregoing management may also re-  
quire the owner to muzzle his guide dog while on their respective  
premises.'
