STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for William Pelky of Winn.

William Pelky; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$40 per month be, and is, granted to William Pelky, of Winn, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1959 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Pelky is 78 years of age. In 1956 he had both legs amputated above the knees. His wife is over 60 years of age and is in poor health. They are trying to live on a railroad pension of \$75 per month.
