STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Providing for a Pension for George A. DeWitt of Bradford.

George A. DeWitt; state pension. Resolve: That a pension of \$60 per month be, and is, granted to George A. DeWitt of Bradford, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1959 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. DeWitt has been a resident of Bradford all of his life. He is now 86 years of age. He has 4 sons, 2 living in Connecticut and 2 living in the State of Maine. His wife is not old enough to receive old age assistance. Mr. DeWitt was a blacksmith until his retirement about 7 years ago.
