AN ACT Exempting Hospital Thrift Shops from Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 17, § 10, sub-§ XXIII, additional. Section 10 of chapter 17 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection XXIII, to read as follows:

'XXIII. Hospital thrift shops. Sales of old clothing by hospital thrift shops conducted by hospital auxiliaries for the benefit of incorporated hospitals.'
