### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Requiring Certain Trucks to Carry Flares.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 22, § 138, amended. Section 138 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 7 of chapter 308 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 138. Trucks 6,000 pounds and over to carry flares. No person shall operate or cause to be operated upon the highways of the State any truck or truck tractor having a registration in excess of 15,000 f,000 pounds unless equipped with 2 red flags, and in addition thereto 3 flares, 3 red lanterns or 3 red emergency reflectors; except that in the case of vehicles used for transportation of inflammable liquids or gas in bulk, such equipment shall consist of 2 red flags, and in addition thereto 3 red electric lanterns or 3 red emergency reflectors.'
