STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Director of Legislative Research.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 10, § 26, sub-§ VII, amended. The last sentence of subsection VII of section 26 of chapter 10 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 473 of the public laws of 1955 and by section 1 of chapter 418 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'He (Director of Legislative Research) shall receive a salary of \$9,000 per year and any necessary traveling expenses;'
