STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Completion of Josias River Project in Ogunquit.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Funds for Josias River Project. The Ogunquit Village Corporation is authorized to appropriate funds and to issue bonds not to exceed \$30,000 for the improvement of the Josias River Project, so called.

Sec. 2. State funds. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Ogunquit Village Corporation the sum of \$30,000 to aid said corporation to complete the Josias River Project, so called. Such appropriation shall not be available until a like amount has been appropriated by the Ogunquit Village Corporation for the same purpose.

Referendum; effective date; certificate to Secretary of State. This act shall take effect 90 days after the adjournment of this Legislature, only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the Ogunquit Village Corporation at any special or annual meeting of the above-named corporation held within one year from the above effective date. Such meeting shall be called, advertised and conducted according to the charter of the Ogunquit Village Corporation, an appropriate article being inserted in the call for such meeting.

The clerk of the Ogunquit Village Corporation shall prepare the required ballots, on which he shall reduce the subject matter of this act to the following question: "Shall the Act Relating to Completion of Josias River Project in Ogunquit, as passed by the 90th Legislature, be accepted?" The voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same.

This act shall take effect for all the purposes hereof immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the voters voting at said meeting and the filing of the certificate with the Secretary of State; but only if the total vote for and against the acceptance of this act at said meeting equaled or exceeded 20% of the number of names on the list of voters of said Ogunquit Village Corporation.

The result of the vote shall be declared by the overseers of the corporation and a certificate thereof shall be filed by the clerk of said corporation with the Secretary of State.

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
