STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Appropriating Moneys for Construction of Men's Dormitory at Maine Vocational Technical Institute.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Maine Vocational Technical Institute; appropriation for construction of men's dormitory. There is appropriated to the Department of Education the sum of \$367,200 from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960, for the construction of a men's dormitory at the Maine Vocational Technical Institute.

Any unexpended balances shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this act have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is to be a masonry building, with 25 two-man rooms, matron's apartment, lounges, snack-bar, kitchen, washrooms, linen and storage rooms, and boiler room. Area, 21,104 sq. ft.

Increased enrollment and faced by crowded conditions at present, additional dormitory facilities will be needed in the future. Dormitory overflow students are now housed in a dwelling house on campus. Even a basement room is used for sleeping quarters. In the fall of 1957 there was not room for all who wished to live on campus. The present dwelling house can be converted to two apartments to house instructors and their families, thus making teaching at M.V.T.I. more attractive.
