**RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Development of Lone Mountain
Jumping Hill, Oxford County.**

Development of Lone Mountain Jumping Hill; appropriation. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$10,000 to the Department of Economic Development to develop Lone Mountain Jumping Hill in Andover, Oxford County, as a skiing area.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

If this skiing area is developed it will accommodate many people for skiing during the winter months. If this area is rebuilt it would be possible to have skiing exhibitions.
