STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Restoration of Certain Forts in Aroostook County.

Restoration of certain forts in Aroostook County; appropriation. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$5,000 to Aroostook County for restoration of the following forts in Aroostook County:

Fort Fairfield at Fort Fairfield;

Fort Kent at Fort Kent;

Hancock Barracks at Houlton.

The expenditure of the appropriation shall be under the supervision of the county commissioners of Aroostook County. Any unexpended balances shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

These forts are connected with the history of the United States and Maine and should be restored for their historical significance and for the benefit of the people.
