HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 714, L. D. 1019, Bill, "An Act Providing
for Open Season on Moose."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by adding at the end, before the
period, the following underlined words:

'and no such license shall be sold after October 27, 1959 for the
open season in 1959 and after October 26, 1960 for the open season
in 1960'

Further amend said Bill in section 3 by adding at the end,
before the period, the following underlined words:

'and no such license shall be sold after October 27, 1959 for the
open season in 1959 and after October 26, 1960 for the open season
in 1960'

Further amend said Bill in section 4 by striking out the last
5 lines and inserting in place thereof the following:

''Sec. 91-A. Open season on moose. There shall be an open
season on moose in 1959 from November 2nd to November 6th and in
1960 from November 1st to November 5th. If the moose kill during
the open season in 1959 exceeds 300, there shall be no open season
in 1960. During the open season it shall be lawful for any licensed
hunter to shoot and have in possession not more than one moose of
either sex.'''
