HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 715, L. D. 1020, Bill, "An Act Relating to Use of Power Boats in Hunting Waterfowl."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end, the following:

"Sec. 3. R. S., c. 37, §89, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 89 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'No <u>duck</u> decoys shall be allowed to remain in waters of Merrymeeting Bay from one hour after legal shooting time until one hour before legal shooting time.'
