AN ACT Relating to Use of Power Boats in Hunting Waterfowl.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37, § 89, amended. The first and last paragraphs of section 89 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, are repealed.

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 37, § 89, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 89 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'The provisions of this and the ~~3~~ 2 following paragraphs shall apply to the waters of Kennebec River, known as Merrymeeting Bay, bounded as follows:

From the high tension wires at Chop's Point to the first dam on the Androscoggin River, to the first road bridge on the Muddy, Cathance, Abbagadasset and Eastern Rivers, and the Richmond-Dresden Bridge on the Kennebec River, being in the Counties of Cumberland, Sagadahoc and Lincoln.'
