Long Lake, Aroostook County, opened to smelt fishing, Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Long Lake, Aroostook County, to fishing for smelts by dip net only.
