IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Local Option for Sale of Malt Liquor by Hotels and Clubs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 61, § 2, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of Section 2 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by chapter 58 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:
- 'II. Shall licenses be granted in this city or town for the sale herein of wine, malt liquor and spirits to be consumed on the premises? (Hotel and Club)'
