STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Permitting Importation of Fireworks for Protection of Agricultural Crops.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 137, § 21, sub-§ IX, additional. Section 21 of chapter 137 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection IX, to read as follows:

ʻIX. To the sale or use of fireworks of the salute type by agricultural growers for the protection of crops from birds, rodents or other wildlife, provided a permit has been obtained for such purpose from the Insurance Commissioner under such regulations as the commissioner deems necessary.'
