IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys to Town of Perry for Development of Recreational Areas.

Town of Perry; appropriation. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$5,000 to be paid to the Town of Perry for the development of camping sites and recreational areas within the limits of said town.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Where Maine is recognized as one of the foremost vacation states and much of the economy of the State is derived from recreational sources, it is essential that there be a continuing development of recreational areas and facilities. The purpose of this resolve is to aid in the development of such facilities.
