COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 368, L. D. 1051, "An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Near Beer to Minors."

Amend said Bill by striking out the underlined words "non-alcoholic cereal" in the fifth line thereof and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'malt' and by striking out at the end thereof the underlined words, figures and punctuation "fine of \$200 or by imprisonment for 6 months, or by both." and inserting in place thereof the underlined words, figures and punctuation "fine of not more than \$100 or by imprisonment for not more than 60 days." "
