STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Prohibiting the Sale of Near Beer to Minors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 138, § 12-A, additional. Chapter 138 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 12-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 12-A. Sale of near beer to minors prohibited. Any person who shall sell to a minor any non-alcoholic cereal beverage under the name of "near beer" or any other name which tends to infer that such beverage has an alcoholic content, or shall sell to a minor any malt extract which may be used in the manufacture of beer shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of \$200 or by imprisonment for 6 months, or by both.'
