STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Disability Retirement Benefits Under the Maine State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 63-A, § 7, sub-§ I, ¶ C, additional. Subsection I of section 7 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section I of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955, is amended by adding a new paragraph C, to read as follows:
 - 'C. In cases where it is established to the satisfaction of the medical board and the board of trustees that the disability involved is of such nature and degree that the recipient is totally incapacitated for the performance of any gainful occupation and is subject to unusual expenses for care, treatment or medicines, an additional amount of monthly benefit to the regular benefit payable under this subsection may be granted in an amount not to exceed 25% of such regular benefit.'
