STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Providing for a Scholarship for Miss Maine.

Scholarship for Miss Maine; provided. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, the sum of \$1,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960 and \$1,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961 in favor of The Miss Maine Scholarship Pageant for the purpose of granting a scholarship to Miss Maine for use at a Maine college.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Junior Chamber of Commerce is franchised by the Miss America Scholarship Pageant to conduct an annual Miss Maine Scholarship Pageant to select Miss Maine through a series of state-wide local pageants and a final state competition. Miss Maine represents the State of Maine at Atlantic City each September, and in appearances throughout the State and Nation.

The primary objective of state, local and national pageants is an ever expanding scholarship award program for all participants who successfully compete in the categories of talent, beauty, wit and charm.
