STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Fur-bearing Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 113, amended. Section 113 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

'Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the open season on all furbearing animals, except beaver, shall be from November 1st of each calendar year to March 1st in the next following year.'
