STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Taking Eels for Trapping Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 57, amended. The last paragraph of section 57 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'The commissioner may issue a permit to any licensed trapper to take not more than 20 pounds of cels annually for use in baiting traps.'
